Research field: applied economics

PhD (Management and Organizational Sciences), 2007 - I defended the title of the economic analysis of the dairy product line, with special regard to price transmission, - and the consumption of dairy products and other factors determining the consumption I explored and presented. Based on this, I concluded that there is a moderate correlation between higher economic development and higher income levels and the level of milk and dairy product consumption. I also carried out a price transmission econometric analysis of asymmetric market conditions within the Hungarian milk vertical in the period between 1995 and 2003, where I quantified the oligopolistic nature of market forces and defined the direction of price determination within the vertical. Using the test methods I developed, it can be easily done in other sectors with a proper database. In the methodology, I examined three possible dimensions (elasticity, asymmetry relations, delay) simultaneously for the Hungarian milk vertical. This allowed me to give a much more nuanced picture of the nature of price transmission than usual in the literature.
